

Contemplation Technology in the Global Process of the Future Primary School Teacher

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Annotation: The article discusses the issues of training innovative and creative modern future primary school teachers in the spirit of high spirituality and patriotism, the formation of technology of competitive tasks and responsibilities of young professionals in the global process, and improving the education system to international standards.

The people of the universe and its world of thought are being enriched today not only in form but also in content. The world education system shows that the intellectual and spiritual image of any nation is formed through national and global pedagogy. In this sense, the fact that the education system in our dear homeland is being renewed in both content and form, gives great hope for the future in the hearts of our people. Accordingly, at the current stage of development of our society, there is a growing need and demand for highly qualified scientific and scientific-pedagogical personnel that meet international standards. It is becoming clear that the social potential and development potential of the countries affected by modern globalization and deep socio-economic modernization is largely determined by the level of development of science and technology, the effective implementation of scientific and practical innovations in various infrastructures of society. Therefore, in Uzbekistan, which is gradually adapting to the world community, a large-scale work is being carried out to modernize the education system, develop science, to introduce modern forms and technologies of teaching. "As we think about solving the complex and important issues facing us in today's rapidly changing world, the solution lies in education, in shaping the worldview of young people with modern knowledge, high spirituality. We are once again convinced that it is related to the formation on the basis of enlightenment" (1-448). At the same time, serious efforts are being made to radically reform pre-school education and primary education, as well as to enrich the content of these areas on an international scale. In this direction, modern and independent thinking, high moral and ethical qualities, training of educated and highly qualified personnel, modern knowledge in the field of professional activity in higher education institutions in the field of preschool education and primary education and Ensuring the quality of training of qualified personnel in the field of information and communication technologies and foreign languages, educational and pedagogical-scientific-methodological, as well as state educational standards of quality, content and level of training and ensuring compliance with the qualification requirements, improving curricula and science programs based on the widespread use of modern pedagogical technologies and teaching methods, raising the educational process to a qualitatively new level and advanced forms of teaching, information- introduction of communication technologies and, most importantly, strengthening the spiritual and moral content in education, youth, independence devotion to their ideas, respect for national values, humanity and the organization of educational work in the spirit of patriotism on the basis of high spiritual ideas. These ideas are reflected in the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On measures to reform governance in higher and secondary special education" (2). Accordingly, the

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roles and responsibilities of the future primary school teacher in the global process are increasing. Because the future primary school teacher is well aware of the process of organizing teaching in the education system, the delivery of the content of science by the teaching professors and the mastery of the students, as well as the system of accurate assessment of their knowledge is not at the required level, as well as the content of educational programs on the organization of the educational process on the basis of modern technologies and the pace of their updating. In fact, the problem is even deeper: higher education and secondary special institutions have not become centers of communication with innovative and technological ideas, the problems and shortcomings in the relevant fields have not been systematically studied. Now it is not only competitive in the republic, but also high-flying. As long as we do not train internationally qualified personnel, we will remain spectators of still unsolved problems in science and education and technology. The fate of the country, the future of the Motherland will be decided by young people who meet international standards. Indeed, if we look at the history of the developed countries of the world, we see that the reforms aimed at changing the life of society in them began with the education system, kindergartens, schools, upbringing as you cannot change a person or a society without changing the school. The foundation of education and upbringing is the school. The driving force behind the school is the teachers. When it comes to the sacred duty to the motherland and the professionals who either destroy or destroy the nation, the world-renowned Singaporean experience and the words of former Singaporean Prime Minister Li Kuan are remembered. Many people ask me about Singapore's development and ask, "How did you break away from a huge country and become a developed country with a small territory? How did you do this "miracle"? " "I didn't do a miracle in Singapore," he said. I have just fulfilled my duty to my homeland. I spent the state budget on education. I promoted my teacher from the lowest level to the highest level in Singapore. The people who do the "miracles" in the country are the teachers. They raised a humble generation who loved science, ethics, hard work and truth. We are grateful to them for that! " said Lee Kuan. The President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev, who deeply understands this glorious idea, chaired a meeting on August 23, 2019 on the development of public education, improving the skills and prestige of teachers in society, raising the morale of the younger generation on the video selector meeting lamented: "Let's ask ourselves: what is our biggest flaw? In level of personnel, in knowledge, in worldview, in patriotism. It would be fair to say that this is not the case. We cannot change people, we cannot change society, we cannot change schools. This is an axiom, no one can deny it. School is a matter of life and death, a matter of the future. It cannot be solved by the state, the government or the governors. This is the work of the whole society, it must become a duty. We can't talk about reforms and results if we don't provide financial incentives to school teachers and improve their quality of life. We will continue to invest in the development of the school system. The fate of our future generation, the fate of our entire nation, our people, our state depends on the respected teachers. " Prospective primary school teachers also have a role to play. Scientific and theoretical bases of future teaching science, its content and application in practice, methods and organization of teaching methods in teaching subjects, advanced teaching and education of students forms and intensive methods, modern, effective forms of assessment of students' knowledge, control methods, rating system for assessing students' activity and mastering, pedagogy, youth psychology and physiology The application of technical means in the educational process, sanitary and hygienic requirements, labor protection, technical and fire safety regulations. The above requirements raise a serious question: and what is its function? When will he be freed from the bondage of thought, the bondage of thought? What are the goals of a future elementary school teacher? What is his responsibility? Professor M. Kuronov, one of the brightest scholars in the field of national education, comments on this issue: It is our duty to heal the spiritual wounds inflicted on us, me and your ancestors, for more than 150 years by the national ideology "(3-6). Continuing his thoughts, the scientist said: "Uzbek character

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has about a thousand qualities. It has both positives and negatives. The most important things we need to get rid of now are: 1. Indifference. 2. Not caring. 3. Localism. 4. Strive not to break the relationship with anyone. 5. Apathy. 6. Lack of knowledge of the essence of reforms. 7. The narrowness of the worldview. 8. Insecurity. 9. Old-fashioned thinking. 10. Priority of personal clocks. 11. The difference between words and deeds. 12. Disappointment, etc. The positive qualities that need to be improved for our national growth are: 1. Spiritual vigilance. 2. Knowledge. 3. Dedication to the cause of the nation. 4. Devotion to the mother tongue. 5. Word and action unit. 6. To take a night off for the homeland. 7. Perseverance. 8. Literacy. 9. Vigilance. 10. Entrepreneurship. 11. Appreciate time. 12. Discipline. 13. Responsibility. 14. Always work on yourself. 15. Patriotism. 16. Honesty. 17. Initiative. 18. Loyalty to duty. 19. Civil liability, etc. Without a project, a multi-storey house cannot be built. Great character too. A clear, scientific approach to the issue requires it. This means creating a model of Uzbek character in the 21st century”(3-22-23). Professor M. Kuronov also explains hundreds of qualities of an Uzbek child in his encyclopedic book "If you want my child to be happy". (4-299-300). These qualities are also the responsibility of future primary school teachers. As the encyclopedist Az-Zamahshari said: This is the best way to make your heart and soul happy and to preserve your glory and honor”(5-21). These grassroots ideas are in line with the wisdom of the scholar A. Navoi: "Improve the face of the world with your mind, make the people of the world happy with your behavior" (6-220). After all, a generation armed with intellect and character, like the Jadid enlightener M. Behbudi, thinks and is ready to give his all for the Motherland: we will wait”(7-142). The proverbs glorifying the happiness of these two worlds are reminiscent of Woodrow Wilson’s famous aphorism: “The dignity of a nation is more valuable than the prosperity of a nation, even the existence of a nation” (8-329). According to A. Avloni, "Loyalty is a spiritual grace, and it is the sacred duty of everyone to receive a share of that grace" (9-67). In the context of this sacred task, the beacon of light shines. That is why, in the words of M. Sabirova, Candidate of Philosophical Sciences, “It is known that any struggle, no matter what, has a specific purpose. The main goal of the ideological struggle is to win the hearts and minds of people, especially young people, to influence the traditional feelings of nations in a particular country or region, to influence and subjugate them. ”(10-71). It is a duty and a duty to acquire knowledge in order not to fall into foreign influence and dependence. Because, as the scholar John F. Kennedy recalled, "Children who do not receive knowledge are children who are lost" (11-110). "If we do not prepare our children for intellectual and spiritual competition with their peers around the world, they will be helpless," said Kuronov. Do you want that to happen? By no means. So, whoever is raising a child at home should consider him (in sports language) a "future world champion". We must create all the conditions for its development and ensure that not an hour is wasted. Then, indeed, every son and daughter of Uzbekistan will become a champion in their field. And we are respected as teachers, coaches, trainers”(12-227). For this, as our world-famous compatriot M. Norbekov said: “Being healthy, living a prosperous life, being happy depends on your level of aspiration, conscience, inner discipline, ability to learn. If you want to use your dormant qualities for now, then you have to work hard”(13-10). Young people who are going to be future elementary school teachers have to work twice as hard. Only then, one of the architects of our national education, M. Kuronov, will be ready to raise the burden of the nation in the international arena to bring up children who are both the face and the eyes of our people: “Spirituality of independent Uzbekistan’s the most difficult burden of educating a healthy young generation, future patriots of the nation, national pride, decency, conscience will ultimately fall on the teacher”(14-190). There is no wish for future primary school teachers, who will raise the Uzbek flag on the path to perfection, except for the grassy call of the true patriotic poetess Halima Khudoiberdiyeva:

Qon aslan yorug’lik. Yorug’lan, tiz cho’k.

Asl mard Vatanga tiz cho'kib o'tar.
