

Current Issues in Foreign Language Teaching Innovations, Traditions, Solutions and Analysis of Fiction

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Abstract: This article is about foreign language teaching, the science of teaching a foreign language, the method of studying the activities of the teacher student, including the methodology of teaching a foreign language, modern and foreign language teaching types of innovative methods, solutions, the place and use of fiction.

Languages that are widely and effectively used in science, technology, international relations, and tourism are among the most advanced languages in the world, and they need to be communicated and promoted not only within one country but also with other nations. Despite the development of modern teaching methods by strong foreign language teachers, almost everyone faces challenges in learning a foreign language.

The problems that arise in the study of foreign languages can be seen mainly in the example of remote areas. Because of the lack of teachers in some areas, there are many problems in teaching foreign languages, and this is a major problem in developing students' foreign language skills. For example, recent data show that there is a shortage of new generation textbooks, modern teaching methods, and teachers with international language certificates in the study of school activities. As a result, the number of students admitted to the university was 27.2%, as a result of which professors and masters of the institute were attached to the schools of the district. In addition, the classrooms where students study are not designed to improve the quality of the lessons, or another reason is that students often try to use English words only when they are under the supervision of a teacher. This makes it difficult to communicate in the language, and teaching students using audio materials helps them better understand the lesson process and pronounce sentences correctly. This is an effective way to improve the quality of lessons and increase students' interest in language learning.

It should be noted that most language learners do not take the learning process seriously, but only rely on grammatical rules, and problems arise, such as loss of interest and a lack of serious approach. In fact, we don't just base our speech on grammatical rules, which can make the speech boring. Or we can see it in non-philological schools, where students treat foreign languages as a second language, and one of their biggest mistakes is that they do their homework. They do not try to learn new words by practicing independently after class. The teacher can help students master 30% during the lesson, and the remaining 70% is learned by the student through self-study. Ignoring the fact that "this is not my language" is one of the worst shortcomings.

In addition, excessive use of the mother tongue can cause problems for students in learning the language. The teacher should speak more foreign languages and require students to communicate in the same language, in fact. Through these methods, they have the opportunity to develop pronunciation and achieve success in a short period of time. It is no exaggeration to say that it is

possible to master it successfully with some restrictions and requirements during the training. After the independence of our country, the interest in teaching foreign languages has increased and many opportunities have been created for young people. As the first President Islam Karimov said, “At present, great importance is attached to the teaching of foreign languages in our country. This, of course, is not in vain. Today, there is no need to underestimate the importance of perfect knowledge of foreign languages for our countries, which are striving to take their rightful place in the world community, and for our people, who are building their great future in cooperation with our foreign partners. “As a logical continuation of these ideas, the Presidential Decree of December 10, 2012 “On measures to further improve the system of teaching foreign languages” expanded the opportunities for learning foreign languages.

In our country, new methods and requirements have been developed in accordance with the recommendations for assessing the skills and experience of teachers in foreign language teaching. New textbooks have been created for schools and vocational colleges, and as the demand for foreign language learning grows, so does the aspect {reading, writing, speaking, and grammar}

Today, innovative ideas in education are the organization of lessons using information technology. Innovative approaches aim to improve the quality and effectiveness of education. The role of innovative learning technologies in language learning and teaching is particularly important, for example, it is not possible to do this without discs or computers for listening comprehension. Listening comprehension is the most important part of language learning, as the learner learns grammatical structure, vocabulary and meaning at the same time. It has become a tradition for young people to play interactive games in the classroom through game technology. Play-based learning helps students develop concentration skills and strong knowledge. According to experts, the psychological mechanisms of conscious activity motivate the individual to rely on self-expression and self-realization. One of the most important requirements in English lessons is to encourage students to think independently. This can be seen in the example of interactive games, such as the game of cards. Quiz cards are one of the most effective types of games in which the teacher can ensure that all students in the group are actively involved in the lesson by organizing the game. Questions are written on the cards and distributed to each student. The student is rewarded for each correct answer (with excellent grades, of course). Increased intellectual competition among students not only improves the effectiveness of the lesson, but also helps students to develop speech and lose the excitement of speaking.

In recent years, the use of new information technologies in schools has become an increasingly important issue. Not only new technical means, but also new forms and methods of language learning are a new approach. The goal is to develop a communicative culture in students and to provide practical training, and the teacher’s task is to create an environment in which each student can express himself or herself. In any case, there will be students in every class who are doing well, and the new technological learning process may even stimulate their interest.

In Uzbekistan, there are a wide range of educational portals in any subject, but there is no modern educational portal. In today’s fast-paced and global world, the use of science resources that do not meet the latest educational standards can lead to a decline in student learning and lower grades, as the use of the latest innovative technologies has become a modern requirement. According to the Resolution of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. PP-5117 of May 19, 2021 “On measures to bring the promotion of foreign language learning in the Republic of Uzbekistan to a qualitatively new level”:

1. Sets out comprehensive measures to promote the study of at least ten high-demand foreign languages; This can lead to the strong teaching of not only English but also other foreign

languages in our country, the organization of the teaching process using new methods and innovative ideas.

2. Develops qualification requirements and assessment criteria for foreign language teachers and organizes the process of awarding them the qualification category on the basis of openness; It is possible to improve the educational process by teaching the most qualified and certified staff, as they have a lot of experience and in addition to the qualification category, they are able to develop students' knowledge and skills that meet modern requirements based on the skills and experience taught.

3. Creating conditions for the development of students' basic language skills (listening, reading, writing and speaking), including the organization of in-depth study of foreign languages by connecting foreign language departments of higher education institutions; Internationally recognized foreign language teaching programs and textbooks are coordinated at all levels of education and all conditions are created for teachers to use these methods, for example, the state allocates them one million sums per month to use modern technologies and be aware of the latest methods.

4. Establishment of mobile groups for training of foreign language teachers of educational institutions under the Agency, in which mobile groups are located primarily in remote areas or to teach foreign languages. The aim is to involve teachers of low-performing educational institutions in professional development. The following are the main activities of schools specializing in foreign language teaching.

The role of fiction in the study of foreign languages is also very important. Because it allows the reader to pay more attention to the literary translation of words, for example, if he reads a story from fiction, he encounters new words during the reading, as well as different meanings of those words, they learn useful techniques such as how to apply in speech. These are very important for language learners to develop their writing skills, such as learning grammar.

The role of modern innovations in educating today's youth to be competitive in the labor market is invaluable. It is our job to teach them at least two foreign languages and create future leaders in them. There are a number of ways to address current issues in foreign language teaching. One of them is that the student should learn the correct pronunciation of sounds and words and use audio materials to make the pronunciation correct. It is a bridge, at least in part, to independently watch foreign language films and language-based videos. Second, the role of teachers in teaching English is great, and motivation and interest in the lesson play a key role. In addition, the use of different methods in language teaching should be considered, as it helps teachers to create appropriate conditions for students to learn English and to help students deal with learning problems.

It has been suggested that the use of innovative methods in English lessons develops students' logical thinking skills, fluency, and the ability to respond quickly and correctly. Such methods stimulate the student's desire for knowledge. The student strives to prepare thoroughly for the lessons. This makes students active participants in the educational process. We can contribute by developing our paths more perfectly. It is important to mature them in all respects and prepare them for tomorrow, realizing that today's rising generation is our future.

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
